

ken-welch.com is a New Zealand-based political blog dedicated to continuing the work of the late Ken Welch (active roughly 2006–2010). It is run by someone named Dom and focuses heavily on **Reverse Speech** analysis applied to politicians, public figures, and world events.

Core Focus and Content

- **Reverse Speech:** The site claims to uncover hidden messages by playing speech backward. Ken Welch taught this technique to the current operator (Dom). The blog analyzes speeches, interviews, and videos of figures like politicians, claiming to bypass "political lies" and reveal true intentions.
- **Key Themes:**
 - An upcoming "Easter Surprise" or "nuclear 9/11" (a planned false-flag nuclear event, originally timed for Easter 2006, now allegedly targeting Iran).
 - A "killer" pandemic (with references to vaccines, protection advice, and possible November 2026 timing).
 - Secret space program, orbital nukes, ET-based weapons, and related conspiracy topics.
 - Criticism of government propaganda, Orwellian systems, Big Oil, and global power structures.

The site includes downloadable MP3s of Ken Welch's old commentaries, PDFs (e.g., pandemic protection, vaccine warnings, NSA protection tips), and regular updates analyzing recent speeches (e.g., from UK, Australian, US, and Palestinian figures) with claimed "reversals" in bold. It also notes visitor stats and has anonymous contact forms.

Background on Ken Welch

The original Ken Welch ran ken-welch.com in the late 2000s, producing content on reverse speech, conspiracies involving governments, and global events. Archives of his old site are linked via the Wayback Machine. The current blog honors him and preserves/extends that work.

Note: This is distinct from other "Ken Welch" figures, such as the current mayor of St. Petersburg, Florida (whose campaign site is kenwelch.com without the hyphen).

The site has a conspiratorial, alternative-news tone and positions itself as independent and uncensored. Content is updated frequently with geopolitical speculation tied to current events (as of mid-2026). You can visit it directly for the latest posts and downloads.
